Thank you for your interest in our Teen Volunteer Program. Most of the opportunities have specific commitments (i.e. a week-long nature camp, 8:30 a.m. -3:30 p.m.). Some of the volunteer positions work directly with staff, while on others you may be required to work on your own or with another volunteer.

Nature Camp Aide. This position will:

- Have required training for new applicants on June 1 from 5:00-7:30 p.m. (You may skip training only with previous approval by nature center supervisor)
- Learn nature connection, safety skills, equipment location, recording volunteer hours, guidelines for behavior, leading games and a general overview of nature camps.

Please complete and return your application to Bear Creek Nature Center as soon as possible and no later than May 10, 2023. Some options have limited positions available and will fill up quickly so please submit your application as soon as possible. I will set up an interview with you to determine where your skills and abilities best fit our needs. You may use this volunteer experience to fulfill community service hours for school and honor societies.
