HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Many products used in the home, garden, garage, and hobby shop contain hazardous chemicals that can potentially harm the user or the environment.

Items marked as follows should be considered hazardous:

“caution”
“causes severe burns on contact”
“danger”
“do not use near heat or flame”
“eye and skin irritant”
“flammable”
“harmful or fatal if swallowed”
“hazardous”
“keep out of reach of children”
“poison”
“use in a well-ventilated area”
“vapor harmful”

Become a label reader
Look for signal words on labels and choose the least hazardous product.

	Signal words	Hazard level
Less hazardous	Caution	mild/moderate hazard
↑ More hazardous	Warning	moderate hazard
	Danger	extremely flammable, corrosive or highly toxic
	Poison	highly toxic

- Buy the smallest amount possible – you can always buy more.
- Read the label and use only as directed.
- Keep products in their original, labeled containers.
- Share leftover products with friends, neighbors, and others who can properly use the product.
- Use them up!

CHEMICALS



Paint, Stains, Solvents, etc.

Latex, oil-based, aerosol, and hobby paints; stains, strippers, solvents, thinners, lacquers, varnishes, etc.



Lawn and Garden

Lawn and houseplant fertilizers, herbicides, insecticides, rodent poisons, wood preservatives, etc.



Household

Aerosols, ammonia, ammunition, batteries, bleach, cooking & lamp oils, cleaners (carpet, drain, oven, toilet), document shredding (*limits & fees apply*), fire extinguishers, fireworks, fluorescent lights, furniture polish/wax, mercury, propane tanks (1-lb & 20-lb), smoke alarms, etc.



Automotive (No tires – see page 28)

Antifreeze, batteries, brake & transmission fluids, motor oil, cleaners (bug/tar, chrome, engine, vinyl), flares, fuels, wax, etc.
